## Overview

Bradfield College is beautifully set in an unspoilt Berkshire village and is one of the leading all-round coeducational boarding schools in the country, seamlessly combining excellent academic education and the highest standard pastoral care in conjunction with well-rounded co-curricular activities.

Each Senior House has a dedicated team of staff and every pupil benefits from the care of a Housemaster or Housemistress, a personal tutor and a matron. Attention to individual needs, and how these may change with progress through the College, is paramount.

The superb facilities at Bradfield include modern teaching and learning environments within the beautiful brick-and-flint original buildings. There is also a modern music school, a sports complex with indoor swimming pool, an indoor tennis centre and two floodlit all-weather pitches as well as exceptional playing fields, golf course and stunning views across the Pang valley.

## **Football**

Bradfield College is renowned for its footballing prowess and on average puts out 20 teams a year to compete at all levels allowing up to 250 boys to participate and they are very successful.

It boasts eleven grass football pitches as well as two All Weather Pitches and two 5-a-side pitches in the sports hall.

There are also house competitions which also come in a variety of formats that include 8-a-side, 6-a-side, 5-a-side and Futsal.

## **Registration Fee & Admissions Process**

£125 Registration Fee. Headmaster or Headmistress reference from pupil's current school, attain satisfactory standard at an Assessment day. Minimum of 6 B Grades or above at GCSE including at least a C in English and Mathematics.
