Overview

Named *Sunday Times School of the Year 2011-12*, and *UK Independent School of the Year 2013-14* Brighton College consistently achieves some of the best A-Level and GCSE results of any co-educational school in England and stands out as one of the UK's most exciting and talked about independent schools as it improves its academic performance every year for the last six.

Extensive facilities including a heated indoor swimming pool, state-of-the-art computer suites, a dance studio, sports hall, cricket nets, tennis courts, rehearsal rooms, fitness suite, the Gilbert Scott Library, and the new Simon Smith Building which provides an outstanding social space and Health Centre.

All pastoral aspects of boarding were classed 'outstanding' by Ofsted in 2009 and by the Independent Schools Inspectorate (ISI) in 2011.

Full boarders enjoy busy weekends with plenty of social activities. Being in the heart of a city renowned for the arts, culture and sport, and with such close proximity to London, the beach and the Sussex countryside, weekends are never dull.

More than 140 activity options, including scuba diving, gymnastics and Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme, provide pupils the opportunities to shine outside the classroom.

Sports Overview

Brighton College has an established reputation for sporting excellence and continues to be one of the country's leading sporting schools. Pupils both past and present have enjoyed success at the highest level and many have gone on to represent their country after leaving the College.

Rugby

Rugby is played as XV' and Sevens with the school fielding 20 teams across all age groups. There are links with professional clubs, Harlequins, Bath and London Irish plus county representation.

Teams compete on a weekly basis before and after Christmas, with Saturday fixtures played against other major independent schools in the South East and nationally.

Football

Each year has four teams playing fixtures every Saturday and the 1st XI also play in the English Schools FA Cup which is a national competition.

The football season starts with a pre-season training camp where the boys enjoy top class coaching in some of the best facilities in the world having recently visited Real Madrid FC and Man City FC.
